Presentation “The Realities of Domestic Violence”
7:30 PM at Neutral Ground

Please join Alli O'Malley, Executive Director of *Safe Journey* (<http://www.safejourney.org/>) for an open forum discussion regarding the realities of domestic violence in our community and nation.

The acceptance of domestic violence as a societal issue and a crime grew out of the feminist movement in the 1970s. Thirty years later our society remains grossly misinformed about domestic violence and ambivalent – or worse, critical – when hearing about it. Domestic violence is a complex issue that is destroying families from all socioeconomic groups at alarming rates. What most fail to understand is that domestic violence is first and foremost a dynamic of power and control and that anyone – children, women, men, - regardless of socioeconomic status, race or faith can fall victim.

Ms. O'Malley will deliver about 90 minutes of domestic violence education, including elements of her own experience as a victim and survivor. Time will be allowed for questions. Ms. O'Malley is a passionate and engaging speaker and her hope is that by speaking with us, she will further break down stereotypes regarding domestic violence and awaken in each of us compassion and hope for its many victims. 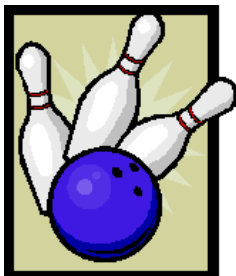
